- Pebbles used in bathrooms bring in a different style making it look trendy and fresh.
- Glass and mirrors can be placed at strategic locations to increase light in the bathroom.
- Right curves can add interest to any bathrooms – an angled wash basin and a curving shower wall opposite to it.

- Lavish display of glass in a small bathroom can enliven and brighten up the place.
- Mirrored cabinets give the additional advantage of spreading light across your bathroom at unexpected angles. Corner bathroom cabinets are important for their space saving benefits.
- Music system built in your bathroom interior designs can be a fantastic way to add coolness factor.
- Modern bathroom interior designs can have some frameless mirrors on the walls and even on the ceiling.



- Modern bathrooms built on the upper floors can have a skylight to usher in natural lighting.
- And if you are looking for energy savings, install LED lights on both sides of the vanity mirror.
- Try creating a 'red brick road' of tiles leading to the shower.
- Try wall art for your bathroom. Wall art like a canvas or photo can make the bathroom look funny or serious. But care needs to be taken that high moisture levels and the occasional water droplets do not damage them.
